**FIELD TRIP TO THE MOUNTAIN VIEW SUBDIVISION LOCATED AT 1500

They found no ground water through digging these test holes. He explained to the Council he felt the water problems that are being experienced by the home owners in the area are due to over watering of their lawns. The Council then adjourned the meeting and went from the City Hall to the Mountain View Estates to view the problems first hand.
