14-06-010. Traffic Signs and Signals.

The City shall place and maintain official traffic signs, signals and markings upon highways under its jurisdiction as necessary to regulate and guide traffic and parking within Woods Cross City and to carry out the provisions of this Title. All signs and signals erected under this Section shall conform to and be maintained in conformance with the Department of Transportation manual and specifications for a uniform system of traffic-control devices under *Utah Code Ann.* § 41-6-20, as amended.

14-06-020. Curb Markings.

The City shall paint and maintain traffic markings upon curbs of any highway under its jurisdiction as necessary to restrict or prohibit the stopping, standing, or parking of vehicles in such areas and to carry out the provisions of this Title. For purposes of this Section, any curb which is painted red shall mean that no stopping, standing or parking is permitted at anytime. For purposes of this Section, any curb which is painted yellow shall mean that stopping, standing or parking is only permitted as designated by appropriate signs. All markings made hereunder shall conform to the provisions of Title 41 of the *Utah Code Annotated*, as amended.

14-06-030. Failure to Obey.

It shall be unlawful for any person to fail to obey any lawfully erected traffic sign, signal or curb marking provided herein, unless otherwise directed to do so by a police officer or other law enforcement or public safety official.
