**13-01-010. Title.**

This Title shall be known as the "Woods Cross City Criminal Code" and may be so cited.

**13-01-020. Omission Not a Waiver.**

The omission to specify or enumerate in this Title those provisions of general criminal law and offenses applicable to all cities shall not be construed as a waiver of the benefits and enforcement of any such provisions.

**13-01-030. Rules of Construction.**

Insofar as possible, the provisions of this Title and the Codes and statutes adopted herein shall be construed in a manner to ensure the enforcement of the criminal laws of the State of Utah. In the event any provisions are inconsistent, the inconsistency shall be resolved as follows:

(a) Any provision of this Title which was at one time, but is not now, consistent with the Codes or statutes adopted herein shall be controlled by the law as it is reflected in the most recent version of the Code or statute, as amended.

(b) Any provision of this Title which deals with the particular local needs and policies of Woods Cross City and is otherwise lawful shall control.

**13-01-040. Penalties.**

Except as otherwise provided by State law or Woods Cross City Ordinances, any violation of this Title shall be a Class B misdemeanor punishable by fine and/or imprisonment as provided in Title 76 of the *Utah Code Annotated*, as amended. This Section shall not limit the authority of the Court to impose any other sanction or order any other relief as may be appropriate and lawful under the laws of the State of Utah.

**13-01-050. Fine Schedule.**

Fines for violations of this Title may be assessed in accordance with the Uniform Fine Schedule as adopted and amended by the Judicial Council of the State of Utah. This Section does not limit the court from, in its discretion, imposing no fine, or a fine in any amount up to and including the maximum fine, for the offense.
