1-03-010. Title.

The Ordinances set forth herein shall be known as the "Woods Cross Municipal Code" and may be so cited.

1-03-020. Citation.

Any provision of state law adopted herein by reference as a City ordinance shall be cited by adding the number of the Title in this Code in front of the section number assigned in the *Utah Code Annotated*. For example, *Utah Code Ann.* ' 76-1-101 adopted by reference in Title 13 of this Code shall be cited as 13/76-1-101. Any reference to the number of any section contained herein shall be understood to refer to the position of the same number, its appropriate chapter and title heading, and to the general penalty clause relating thereto, as well as to the section itself, when reference is made to this Code by title in any legal documents.

1-03-030. Amendments.

Any ordinances adding to, deleting from, or altering any part of this Code shall constitute an amendment thereto and shall be adopted by ordinance of the City Council.

1-03-040. Updates to Code Books.

The City Recorder shall ensure appropriate procedures are provided to assure replacement pages are properly inserted in official copies of the Code. Any person having custody of an official copy of the Code shall make every effort to maintain said Code current as to the most recent ordinances passed and shall follow all instructions for immediate insertion of replacement pages. Copies of official Code books, while in actual possession of officials and other employees, shall be and remain the property of the City and shall be returned to the office of the City Recorder when directed to do so by the City.

1-03-50. Repealer.

Unless otherwise specifically provided herein, all general ordinances of the City passed prior to the adoption of this Code are hereby repealed. The following ordinances are not hereby repealed: tax levy ordinances, appropriation ordinances; ordinances relating to boundaries and annexations; franchise ordinances and other ordinances granting special rights to persons or corporations; contract ordinances and ordinances authorizing the execution of a contract or the issuance of warrants; salary ordinances; fee ordinances; ordinances establishing, naming or vacating streets, alleys or public places; improvement ordinances; bond ordinances; ordinances relating to the transfer or acceptance of real estate by or from the City; and all special ordinances.

1-03-060. Accrued Rights.

The repeal of ordinances provided in Section 1-03-050, nor any provisions of this Code and any amendments thereto, shall not affect any debt or fee which is accrued, any right which is accrued, any duty imposed, any penalty incurred, nor any action or proceeding commenced at the time when this Code or any amendments thereto takes effect, nor shall the repeal of any ordinance hereby have the right of reviving any ordinances already repealed or superseded, unless the ordinance containing the amendment or repealer indicates otherwise.

1-03-070. Continuation of Prior Ordinances.

The provisions appearing in this Code, so far as they are the same as those of ordinances existing at the time of the effective date of this Code, shall be construed as continuations thereof and not as new enactments.

1-03-080. Omission of General Law Not Waiver.

The omission to specify or enumerate in this Code those provisions of the general law applicable to all cities shall not be construed as a waiver of the benefits of any such provision.

1-03-090. Severability Clause.

If any title, chapter, section, subsection, sentence, or provision of this Code is, for any reason, held to be unconstitutional, invalid, void or unlawful by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Code.
