

Be Prepared

Verify Your Voter Registration

Make sure your voter registration is current and that your ballot will be sent to the correct address. If you are going to be away from home during the election you may request your ballot be sent to an alternate address. Visit Voter.Utah.gov. The deadline is October 25th, but please do not wait until the deadline.

Sign Up For Notifications

You can receive notifications by text, email, or phone call when your ballot is mailed, received in our office, and counted. Sign up at BallotTrax.Utah.gov

Watch For Your Ballot

Ballots will be mailed on October 15th and will begin arriving shortly afterwards. If you have verified your voter registration and mailing address is correct but have not received your ballot by October 22nd, please call our office at 801-451-3213.

Study Candidates and Issues

Information about candidates and ballot issues can be found at DavisVotes.com or Vote.Utah.gov. Make sure you get information from trusted sources such as official government websites, candidate websites, or trusted media outlets.

Vote Your Ballot

Mark your ballot following the instructions on your ballot. If you write in a candidate, be sure to use the candidates first and last name. Use a dark pen to mark your choices. Each envelope is unique, make sure you have the envelope with your name on it. Only you may sign for your ballot, and you may not sign for any other person, even with permission. If you are unable to vote a paper ballot or sign your own envelope independently and you need assistance, please contact our office for additional options.

Return Your Ballot

If you return your ballot in the mail, please return it as soon as possible, but no later than Friday November 1st. Ballots returned in the mail must be postmarked before November 5, 2024. If you wait, your ballot may not receive a timely post mark and will not be counted. Please do not wait until the deadline. Ballots may also be returned in any Official Ballot Drop Box until November 5th at 8pm. In person voting locations are also available (See our website for locations).

Transparency in Elections

Security of our elections is among our highest priorities; an important component of this is ensuring public transparency. During this election there are several public events in which you can observe to help ensure our elections are secure.

October 11th at 10:00 am – A pre-election test and audit of our voting equipment will be held to ensure all equipment used in the election will count ballots correctly.

October 16th at 6:00 pm – Election Town Hall and Tour of our election facility. Election staff will be available to answer any questions you may have and walk you through how we administer elections in Davis County.

October 17-November 18 – Ballot processing. You can watch ballots being delivered and counted in our elections observation area. All processes are visible within six feet or less. Visit DavisVotes.com to view our election calendar for specific times.

November 15th at 10:00 am – A post-election audit will be conducted to ensure the voting equipment counted ballots accurately.
